→ Parents will provide a crib sheet and blanket for their child. These items should be taken home on Fridays, washed, and returned on Monday mornings.

→ No child shall be admirred who has a household member experiencing Covid-19 or a connagious/infectious disease unless a written doctor's excuse is presented stating the student is negative/cleared for return to school. A minimum of 5 days should pass after exposure before return.

- The parent or legal guardian shall be notified as soon as possible when a child has any symptom that requires exclusion

 The parent or legal guardian shall be separated from other children and closely monitored until the parent arrives to pick the child up.
- → The caregiver shall determine if the illness prevents the child from participating comfortably in activities, results in a greater need for eare than the child care staff can provide without compromising the health and safety of the other children, or poses a risk of spread of harmful discusses to observe.
 → The caregiver shall temporarily exclude the child from child eare if the child has: Sudden

change in behavior, such as:
- lethargy or lack of responsiveness
- unexplained irritability or persistent crying

 fever over 101 degrees/oral, 100/axillary (or equivalent method) in a child who also has pain, behavior changes, or other symptoms of illnes
 An infart younger than 2 months with any increased temperature shall get urgent medical attention, within an bour.
